

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

idol, or spirit, or even some other man can reconcile us to God, ONLY Jesus. No Indian spirit, no Buddha, no Allah, nothing except the Son of God, Jesus.

We must come to God His way, the only way, through Jesus Christ, the Son of God and faith in Him. Jesus Himself told us, "I am the way, the truth, and THE LIFE: no man comes unto the Father except by me."(John 14:6) Is God's Word truth or not? There is ONLY ONE WAY to God period!

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

A covenant established with Abraham 430 years before the "Mosaic Law" (the core of which is the Ten Commandments) was given to Moses.

Just as any loving parent treats even a rebellious child better than they deserve, the only requirement to receive this covenant of love is that our hearts must be tuned to love and honor God as God.

He only asks that we love Him and Keep His commandments, do what He said to do in His Word, daily. We must not think of Him as just a good luck charm or a weekly guest into our otherwise busy lives. What we do must be done in awareness that it is done before His eyes and must be done for Him! Everything we do must bring Glory and honor to Him as God.

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

Ut of the tiniest of seeds huge trees grow! A very small acorn can produce a giant majestic oak tree over time.

Whatever we sow is what we will reap. As Creflo Dollar would say "You don't plant corn if you want collard greens!" This principle runs true throughout all of life. It is a principal ordained by God and it controls nature. When we sow to the flesh (or the carnal, lustful sin nature of man) by yielding to such things as alcohol, tobacco, drugs, greed, anger, pornography and other such lusts of the flesh, we will only reap the destruction that will come from it. ("For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our

Lord." Romans 6:23) (or all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, Romans 3:23)

Take a good look at modern society today and you will see what I mean. Men with men and women with women, and trying to tell the world it's okay. It is NOT okay, it is not what God intended for us to do. Even the animals don't live like that. Why else would He have made male and female? Adults sexually abusing children, pornography all over the internet and even cable TV. Liars, cheaters, and illegal aliens as politicians, even a president.

The list just goes on and on. We cannot get completely away from the seeds we have already sown, but we can control what seeds we will sow in the future.

We can control our future harvest. It is possible to uproot the seeds before they sprout, if you will turn to God and His Word. So let's not fool ourselves by trying to do a "snow job" on God. He knows what you are sowing, just like you know what you are sowing. If you're sitting in front of the 'boob tube' all evening instead of meditating the Word guess what your harvest is going to be?

Ever wonder why they call the television the 'boob tube'? Seek first the Kingdom of God. Sow to the spirit and spiritual things instead of to the flesh, and you will reap eternal life. Yes, those things of the flesh seem pleasant and fun to do, BUT it is only for a little while

and then there is a price to pay. If it's not of faith in the things of God, it's sin. Sin, when mature produces death.

Let's make sure the seeds we sow are the ones we want sprouting up later! Remember God SEES and HEARS all that you do and say and He even knows what is in your heart!

To have a "Testimony" to share. After all He has made us able ministers of the Gospel (2 Cor. 3:6). To do this we must be meditating His Word always. We must have an abundance of the Word in our hearts for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks!

But when we share this hope with others, two things are very important:

Our credibility -- is Jesus really Lord of our hearts and our lives -- Do we walk the talk? Are we really living the life of the Christian.

1: Our credibility -- is Jesus really Lord of our hearts and our lives -- Do we walk the talk? Are we really living the life of the Christian faith in Jesus, or do we merely just talk the talk? Do we show up for Church on Sunday and then live like the rest of the world all week? Smoking, drinking, cursing, and carrying on as the unsaved do.

As Christians, we MUST live by faith, we MUST walk the talk always! Four (4) times in God's Word He tells us the just (those who are in right standing with Him) must live by faith.

2. Our character -- do we show gentleness and respect in our approach and speak in love? Are we lead by the Holy Spirit and His inner promptings when we tell others about Jesus? Or do we preach condemnation to them for the way they are? (I hope not!)

Do we tell them what is theirs already through Jesus according to the Word if they will only believe?

Do we tell them that God loves them and wants them to love Him. We must preach the Gospel (the "Good News"), not the "Law". No man is justified by the Law. The goal is not to win arguments, but to win hearts and souls to Jesus!

Joly and Loving Father, thank You for sending Your grace in and through Jesus. Thank You for having Your Word (Jesus) become flesh and dwell among us.

Thank You for giving us an example to live by. I'm sure I would not have believed any other message than that of the "Good News" (the news of what Jesus had done for me!)

How else will we be able to teach one another or correct, warn or caution each other about bad spiritual habits.

We need the wisdom of God which can only be obtained through an intimate fellowship with Christ and

His Word on a daily basis. When we are full of His Word then our praise and spiritual songs will flow from the fullness of our hearts. When we are full of His Word our faith will show it!

But freedom is not to be free to indulge in sin and feed the sinful fleshy nature of man. Freedom is not to be able to sin and then run to confession on Sunday. Freedom is freedom through grace to serve God and one another in love. Freedom is knowing that if you mess up, you can come to God and confess and He will forgive you and cleanse you of ALL unrighteousness.

Pharaoh's grasp, David from the sword of Goliath, and Daniel from the lion's den. In the Hebrew language the word translated here as covenant has the meaning that there is to be a cut or incision made implying "Blood Covenant". H1285. beriyth, ber-eeth'; from H1262in the sense of cutting [like H1254]); a compact (made by passing between pieces of flesh).

God made this "everlasting" covenant with Abraham and with his seed after him for generations.

Abraham "cut" the covenant with God for us and then it was ratified through Jesus.

If you are a "born-again" believer, if you have asked Jesus to be the Lord of your life, then you are Abraham's seed. You have a part of this covenant with God Almighty!

You have a right to expect and claim the things promised by God to Abraham and his seed as long as you keep your part. As this New Year comes to a close and we prepare for the beginning of a new year take a stand and stand on God's Word to you and believe for an exceedingly abundant and fruitful year! And then go out and do your part, what you were called to do.

Not Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, nor Baptist, or Catholic, or Protestant, or

Nazarene, or some other denomination, but only Jesus Christ and Him crucified for you!

When we get to Heaven there won't be any denominations people, only the saints who gave their life to Jesus while still on Earth. Oh and by the way, the Bible says we are ALL saints once we make Jesus the Lord of our lives! Not only Saints, but Kings and Priests unto God also!

Peter wasn't Pastor Peter or Reverend Peter, or 1st Pope Peter when he went out and told the people about the Gospel. He was just a believer, a disciple of Jesus, baptized with the Holy Spirit and fire that Jesus promised us and told us to receive before we went out. "(Zec 4:6 KJV) Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts." Have you told anyone about Jesus today?

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

What is it we are supposed to hear? The six o'clock news, the New York Times, the Kitsap Sun, the Seattle Times newspaper, Spike TV, M-TV, HBO Cable Network, CNN News, ESPN news, your neighbor next door, the guy down at the gas station, or some other news broadcasting station?

No, we are supposed to be hearing and hearing by the WORD of GOD concerning Jesus Christ and Him crucified for us.

We should be meditating on His Word day and night. We need to choose very carefully what we listen to, what we watch, and whatever else is feeding our natural senses, because our spirit man, the real us, is fed through the eye gate, the mouth gate, and the ear gate.

Whatever we're seeing, speaking, and hearing the most is what is going to get into our hearts (our spirit man). God said out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

In Proverbs it says: Keep (Guard) your heart with all diligence, for out of it [spring] the issues of life. We need to put on a spiritual filter and make sure that what we are hearing and seeing lines up with the Word of God, so that what we are speaking is also from God. Because if it doesn't line up with God's Word it will have the opposite effect of building faith...it will destroy Faith and cause unbelief. Remember, whatever is NOT of faith is sin.
