THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

Love is more than an emotional feeling, it is action, it is a way of living. As believers, the action, the way of living, that most shows our love for Jesus is our obedience to His Words and His example.

The Bible relates men as being like trees. A tree does NOT have to verbally tell you what kind of tree it is, the fruit lets you know what kind of tree it is.

Chapter 14: Are you filled with the entire Godhead?

J or in Him (Jesus) the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature].

And you are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life [in Christ you too are filled with the Godhead - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - and reach full spiritual stature]. And He is the Head of all rule and authority [of every angelic principality and power].

--Col 2:9-10 Amplified Version

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

All the fullness of the Godhead (the triune God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) dwells in Jesus Christ (as a man). I didn't say that the Bible did. Remember He was the Word become flesh and dwelt among us (John 1:14). In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God! (John 1:1)

If the Word became flesh and dwelt among us and the Word was God, then Jesus is God bodily or in the form of humanity. Now if you are in Him and He is in you then you are complete in Him. Then we have the full

power of the Godhead dwelling within us, if we are born again, if we are in Christ!

Why aren't we walking in the miracles that followed Jesus? We need to learn to put a demand on that power of God that dwells within us.

Quit asking God to come and do something that He has already done and given you both the power and authority to do yourself in His place! We need to bring forth all the power of the Godhead when we speak or act according to the Word of God. We need to expect the same results that Jesus got, that Paul got, which Peter and John got at the gate beautiful.

We need to walk in the fullness of that Godhead! How has it come to pass that this isn't happening? I'll tell you why, because of the doctrines of men (religion) that have crept stealthily into the Church over the ages from the very beginning. Because of the doctrines of men keep telling us the power has passed away.

Do you know why they say this? They don't know the Word and they don't know how to walk in it, so they tell us it's passed away. That's not what it says in His Word! It's time to get them (the wrong doctrines) out and Christ back in!

Remember, all that really matters is "Jesus and His death, burial, and resurrection on high!" The same power that raised Christ from the dead dwells in you. (If you are a born again Christian).

MY PRAYER...

Precious Father, help me to understand the fullness of Your power that dwells within me. Give me a revelation of what it is like and what it is for.

Help me to put aside all things of the natural that hinder me and to learn to expect the same results that Jesus and the early church got when they applied Your Word to sickness, disease, and evil spirits.

Lord, let the power of Your Holy Spirit manifest itself fully in all that I do and say so that the world will see the Glory of the Lord manifested bodily. But always remind me (caution me) to guard my heart and to give You all the Glory and all the honor.

Father I will that Your Kingdom come and Your will be done here, now, on earth as it already is in heaven. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Chapter 15: Are you Holy before God?

 \mathfrak{J} ust as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."

-- 1 Peter 1:15-16 New International Version

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

"Doly" is one of those words we generally associate with the religious people (Pharisees & Sadducees) a word only "religious church folks" (those who live under the Law –the Ten Commandments) use.

That may be true, but it's still a great concept. Every kid knows that you don't eat hot dogs and potato chips on Mom's best china.

Mom's china is reserved for "special company" or "special occasions." Or is it? Should it be? When God is calling us to be holy, He's calling us to be like fine china something special just for Him, and as Peter emphasizes, just like Him (JESUS).

The Greek word translated here as holy could also have been translated: sacred, pure, blameless or consecrated unto God. God wants us to be set apart from the world -

but also consecrated unto Him.

God wants us to stand out as not being like the world around us, but different. Different in that we are like Him Holy and Righteous in the eyes of God regardless of what is going on around us. Different in that the light and love of God shines forth from us to those around us that we meet. That is what being Holy is about.

MY PRAYER...

Poly Lord, Almighty God, I come before You knowing how great the distance is between Your holiness and my commonness. But, I thank You for making me holy and righteous through the sacrifice of Jesus and by sending Your Holy Spirit to live inside of me.

Please receive my life today as a holy offering to You. Empower me to become and live the righteousness of You. Through Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter, the author and the finisher of my faith I pray. Amen.

Chapter 16: Have you received the Grace of God?

De, who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification. Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

We only need, by our faith to reach out and take that which He has already provided. Don't ask Him to do it again, He's already done it once and made it available to us. Just receive it!

Because Godly power will always be accompanied by love and administered in love, with the mind of Christ (a sound mind). God has given us His Holy Spirit (the power), Himself (agape or the God kind of love), and Jesus our example (a sound mind).

These three together make a person's life effective. Live life to its fullest through Christ; not as a closet Christian, afraid of standing true and firm, but one who lives by God's power, shares God's love, and displays God's virtues. One who isn't afraid that the world might find out they are a Christian, God forbid.

The world isn't afraid of sharing their garbage with us why should we be afraid of sharing Jesus and our faith with them. It is after all what the Bible says we are to

do! "And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15) Be always ready to minister in God's power and Love, with the wisdom of God through the mind of Christ, in season and out.

Doly Father God, You are without comparison in Your majesty and might. I have no right of my own to come into Your presence, and yet You have invited me there with Your love and by Your grace, through Christ. You are my Rock, my Fortress, and my Strength.

Chapter 26: Jesus is the Great Reconciler!

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

Be reconciled to each other before you offer anything to God. What is Jesus saying here? He's telling us that the altar (our hearts, we are the temple of the living God under the New Covenant) is more important than the gift being offered.

God is more concerned about our heart condition toward each other than He is about a gift or offering or sacrifice to Him.

Make sure you have prepared your heart and that you come to Him having a pure heart, not holding any un-forgiveness toward anyone.

Precious Father, thank You for forgiving me, for cleansing me of all unrighteousness through the precious blood of Jesus.

Father, let me see the revelation of the teaching offered in these verses. Help me Father, to understand that we must come to You with only a pure heart.

A heart that holds no malice or un-forgiveness, but only love. The Love of God that has been shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit.

Father, take me and purge me with Your Refiner's Fire and remove all un-forgiveness, strife, envy, and anything else that is not a part of Your Love from me. Father, make me a vessel You can use for Your Glory. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Chapter 27: Who are you following?

ou can always give thanks for someone because of the grace given to you by the Lord Jesus Christ. Here Paul was writing to one of the most fleshly, worldly churches of the day.

They loved God, but they lived like the rest of the world around them day to day. It was difficult to distinguish between them and the heathens around them. But notice that he still finds reasons to give thanks for them. In Paul's letter to them, he is thankful for them because Jesus died for them.

Later he recognizes the areas of their abuse are also a reason to give thanks - they may have distorted their gifting's, but when reined in to where they honor God,

these gifts will bless their church. Even though Paul followed these thanks with some really tough words, Paul's example reminds us that a child of God is something to be cherished, even if they have problems. We need to show them the love of God even when we are correcting them. "For whom He loves, He chastens." Remember, babes need to be taught how to act and behave, they don't automatically know just because they are born.

MY PRAYER...

recious Father, increase within me the heart to see reasons to be thankful for all of Your children. I confess that it is often so easy for me to view others based on how they view me, or whether they share my opinions, or how much trouble they cause me.

Father forgive me for this, I know if You had done the same with me, I would have never been one of Your children. Please help me to change the way I view others.

Help me to see them as You see them, through the Blood of Jesus. Please help me rejoice in Your children. Through Jesus I pray. Amen.

Chapter 29: Have you received the Grace of God?

J or the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and Godly, in this present world;

THOUGHTS ABOUT TODAY'S VERSE...

In a world that has no absolutes, in a world that is lacking moral and ethical standards, a world that sees men with men and women with women as an okay lifestyle when it is an abomination to God, salvation by the costly grace of God beckons us to change our lifestyle in response to God's grace.
