BELIEVER'S AUTHORITY

Jesus said, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." He also told us, "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. The key to believer's authority is knowing who you are in Christ.

In this verse the Greek word "exousia" is used and actually means privilege, mastery, delegated influence, authority, or jurisdiction.

In the first usage of power the Greek word "exousia is used and in the second usage of power the Greek word "dunamis" is used and means force, miraculous power, ability, might, or strength. Note however that the translators chose to translate both as power instead of "Authority" and "Power" respectively.
